The Board of Supervisors met this 4th day of October 2022, at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Lonnie Mayberry, Carol Vinton and Richard Crouch were present.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to approve the consent Agenda and Minutes from September 27, 2022. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Randy Romans and Shawn Koehler were present at their scheduled time to update the Board on the Trails Project financing and status - currently under budget.

Jacob Ferro, Mills County Engineer, was present for his scheduled meeting. Ferro informed the Board on current Utility Reports: Septic line, 64477 Painters RD, Stroud Pumping; Conduit Under Barrus RD to Ohana Subdivision, MidAmerican Energy; 2" Conduit to New Home 23907 Gaston Ave, MidAmerican Energy; 2" Conduit to New Home 23388 Gaston Ave, MidAmerican Energy; 2" Conduit to New Home, 63405 240<sup>th</sup> ST, Mid American Energy; 2" Conduit to New Home, 17788 Kane Ave, MidAmerican Energy; Replace Copper Cable, 32371 Lambert Ave, Tele Com; Fiber from home to pedestal, 50602 Hwy 275, Tele Com; Fiber from terminal to pedestal, 63407 Levi Rd, Tele Com.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry on Approval of Snyder Design Proposal for Bridge on 400<sup>th</sup> St., South of Jameson near Emerson. Cost is \$129,900, a unique project with the railroad for a Single Span Bridge looking to partner with Hungry Canyons for weir & culvert replacement due to erosion. Hoping to let this project over the winter. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to Approve Promotion of Trent Moore to Road Foreman on October 10, 2022 @\$28.50/hr. Moore has been with Mills County since 2017. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Keith Johnson, Oak Township Clerk, was present for his scheduled meeting. Johnson stated they are looking at replacement of their tanker truck. Currently they are screening used trucks and would like to have a mechanism to act quickly. Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to authorize Oak Township to borrow funds for the purpose of fire prevention. Oak Township serves a large area of fire and rescue. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to accept resignation of the County Attorney effective at end of her term, December 31, 2022, or when someone is appointed. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Authorization to change Victim Witness Coordinator position from part time to full time has been tabled until more information is available.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry to move forward with the process to advertise for the position of County Attorney to fill a vacancy. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to set date for Public Hearing for Whitetail Run Preliminary Plat Approval for October 18, 2022, at 10:00 am. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 3, Nays: 0

The Auditor will work on putting together a publication for those individuals interested in cash renting buyout properties.

The Board received the Recorder's September Month Report of fees. The Board has been gifted 2 tickets to the Community Betterment Beautification Awards on October 27<sup>th</sup> and will need to determine who will use them.

There being no further business to come before the Board, they adjourned to meet on October 11, 2022.
