RESOLUTION 26-08

RESOLUTION OF THE MILLS COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING SPEED REDUCTION TO 35 MPH NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF 221ST STREET AND BARRUS ROAD

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 321.285, Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors and the County Engineer are empowered to declare a reasonable and proper speed limit for secondary roads, and

WHEREAS, Mills County has examined traffic conditions near the intersection of 221st Street and Barrus Road due to the activity related to hauling material from Barrus Road to the Google Site in Pottawattamie County, and,

WHEREAS, Mills County has determined that a posted speed limit of 35 MPH for the area near said intersection for a distance of 1,500 feet (750 feet north and 750 feet south of the intersection) will improve the safety conditions in that area, and,

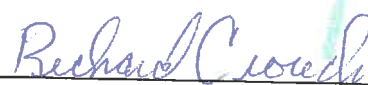
WHEREAS, Mills County Secondary Roads Department will erect new 35 MPH speed limit signs in the area designated above, and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mills County Board of Supervisors in session this 3rd day of February 2026, recognizes the official speed reduction from 55 MPH to 35 MPH north and south of the intersection of 221st Street and Barrus Road for a total distance of 1,500 feet.
